<sup>\*</sup>Note about canoe transfers: in the BriBri community, many areas are only accessible by canoe. Canoe transportation will not require students to paddle (the canoe has a small motor and is steered by a local canoe skipper), participants will wear a life jacket during the transfers, and the rivers are highly transited by other canoes who would be able to support if a participant were to fall overboard.
